Schedule of Classes

Flowers

- 1 One vase of 10 cut mixed Daffodils, any varieties
- 2 One vase of 3 cut Daffodils one variety only
- 3 One vase of 6 cut mixed Tulips, any varieties
- 4 One vase of 3 cut Tulips one variety only
- 5 **[NEW CLASS]** One cut tulip to be displayed in a brown 500ml beer bottle, with the flower resting on the top, which is a traditional way of showing specimen blooms (Google 'Tulips in Beer Bottles' for inspiration)*
- 6 One container of cut Primulae, Polyanthus or Primrose with or without foliage, 5 stems
- 7 One vase of flowers from trees and/or shrubs, not more than 3 varieties and maximum of 5 stems
- 8 One vase with stems of any flower not specified above
- 9 One pot or bowl of one or more alpine or rockery plants in flower
- 10 One specimen succulent or cactus plant
- 11 One container of growing bulbs or corms in flower, any variety or varieties
- 12 One Orchid (must have been in your care for 6 months prior to the show)
- 13 One Primula in a pot, any variety
- 14 One foliage pot plant
- 15 One flowering pot plant in flower, any variety not specified above

- 16 A Spring Design without Foam
- 17 "Flowers in a Tea Cup"

Photography

- 18 A Photograph depicting 'The First Signs of Spring'

Baking

- 19 A Lemon Drizzle Cake
- 20 4 Plain or Fruit Scones
- 21 4 Jam (Jammy Dodger) Sandwich Biscuits

Children's Classes

- 22 Reception and Years 1 and 2 - TBA
